

01. Working alone

• E.g., report, spreadsheet, presentation



02. Team, Group, Department

- Communication: 2-way / private
- Meetings
- Tasks
- Document collaboration
- Permission: read/write



03. Larger Audience

- Communication: 1-way / public
- Document management
- Permission flexibility: read-only & edit

Team Site

Communication Site





One-way / public communication

Appropriate for a department, group or team (internal)



Appropriate for external departmental / company communication

Every member of the team has readwrite access



Permission flexibility, depending on roles (e.g., read-only, editing etc.)



Ideal for internal collaboration on tasks and documents



Ideal for more 'public-facing' information e.g., final policies, newsletters, events etc.
